Dear Parents/ Carers,

On Monday 3rd June the NSPCC came in to school to talk to the children about how to stay safe. They worked with years 5 and 6 on recognizing different kinds of abuse and protective behaviors.

All the children should have brought home a petunia this week. Please help your child to keep it healthy, and return it to School on Friday 5th July in time to be entered into the Glaphorn and Southwick Show the next day. Don't forget to put your child's name and age on a lolly stick with the petunia, and please bring back the original pot so it can be used again next year.

Parents were treated to an amazing Cluster Orchestra performance on Wednesday evening at St. Peter's Church in Oundle. Children from across the cluster schools performed together brilliantly, after spending the whole day rehearsing. This is a unique and special opportunity for our primary school children, which would usually only be offered to secondary pupils. Yesterday, some of our year 5 and 6 scientists spent the day in the SciTech lab at Oundle School enjoying taster sessions in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Engineering. They were particularly delighted to come home each with their own DNA in a phial around their necks!

We have a very busy few weeks ahead of us! Next week is Health Week (for Barn Owls this will be the week commencing Monday 1st July). Information for parents has been sent home this week. Please let class teachers know as soon as possible if you would like to withdraw your children from the Sex and Relationships sessions during the week.

'Move up' day for all Glaphorn pupils takes place on Thursday 18th July. This is an opportunity for children to spend time in the classes they will be in from September, with their new teachers (if applicable).
